VA24 (below) is located in Prince Edward County, Virginia, near Twin Lakes State Park. NTN sampling began at the site on January 26, 1999. Sampling for the Clean Air Status and Trends Network (CASTNet) is also conducted on site.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency sponsors and operates VA24. Jon Bowser of MACTEC Engineering and Consulting, Inc. is the site supervisor and Gene Brooks is the site operator.

UT01 Logan

UT01 (above) commenced NTN sampling on December 6, 1983. The site is located at a National Weather Service (NWS) Co-Op station known as Logan 5 SW (South West), which was established in May of 1956. The elevation is 4,490 feet above mean sea level. The U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) sponsors the site. The Utah Climate Center (based at Utah State University) operates UT01, takes NWS observations, and oversees Colorado State University's UVB monitoring project also located at this site. Esmail Malek is the site supervisor and Tess Davis is the site operator.
