

IA08 Big Springs Fish Hatchery



IA08 (at left) began NTN sampling on August 14, 1984. It is located in Northeast Iowa at the Iowa Department of Natural Resources Big Springs Fish Hatchery in Elakder. This hatchery raises approximately 250,000 rainbow and brown trout for public fishing. Trout stream stocking begins April 1st and continues until November 1st.

The U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) sponsors and operates IA08. Mike Linhart of the USGS is the site supervisor. Robert Zach (pictured) started working at the Big Springs Fish Hatchery in January 1966 and worked there until his retirement in January 1996. He has been operating the NTN site since 1991.
