

Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument

MT00 is located at Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument, the site of the June 25-26, 1876, battle between the U.S. Army's 7th Cavalry and several bands of Lakota Sioux, Cheyenne, and Arapaho. In 1881, a memorial was erected on Last Stand Hill over the mass grave of the 7th Cavalry soldiers, U.S. Indian Scouts, and other personnel killed in battle. In 1991, the U. S. Congress changed the name of the battlefield (from Custer Battlefield National Monument) and called for the design, construction, and maintenance of a memorial and monument to recognize the Indians who fought in the Battle of the Little Bighorn. The memorial was dedicated on June 25, 2003.

NTN sampling began at MT00 on July 13, 1984. The U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) is the sponsoring agency and the USGS and the National Park Service are the operating agencies. Lonnie Hergenrider is the site supervisor, Les Frickle (pictured on the left) has operated the site since 1987, and Wayne Not Afraid (pictured on the right) is the backup operator.
