



The tornado removed 300 feet of blacktop asphalt from a paved road and rolled two 90-ton oil tanks a distance of 3 miles and put them 600 feet up the side of a mountain.*</i> <i>June 22, 1919 - An F5 tornado struck the town of Fergus Falls, Minnesota. 59 people were killed and 400 buildings were destroyed. Lumber was carried for 10 miles and a blank check was carried a distance of 60 miles, setting a new record for distance a check bounced.*</i> <i>June 22, 1947 - 12 inches of rain fell in 42 minutes at Holt, Missouri, setting a new rainfall intensity world record.*</i>
