1. Tom Lavery was elected Secretary.
2. Delivery of methyl Hg data from HAL to Program Office
 - a. Discussion of methyl Hg measurements

Some methyl Hg data are measured from standard Hg samples and some from composite samples

Analytical issues: separate analytical method with separate flags and some concentrations are below detection limits (report detection limits)
 - b. **Motion:** Submit the data via Excel to Clyde Sweet who will work with Bob Larson to ingest data. Subsequent discussion suggested:
 1. Delivery of data to Clyde and Bob on 6/1. They will review data.
 2. Based on data review, prepare proposal for methyl Hg data.
 3. Submit proposal to executive committee on 8/27.
 - c. **Motion:** Submit methyl Hg data on same schedule as total Hg.
 - d. Motion passed.
3. Passive ambient NH₃ sampling in Illinois
 - a. use Ogawa passive samplers to measure NH₃ and estimate dry deposition
 - b. install network in Champaign-Urbana area and evaluate approach
4. Integrated coding system for NTN, AIRMoN, and MDN
 - a. **Motion:** one year to fix times (all GMT) and apply codes uniformly and reconcile any remaining differences
 - b. Motion passed.
